



Otteson Award Nomination Form

Each year the Kelley School of Business Indianapolis Student Government (KSBISG) provides an opportunity for students to recognize undergraduate faculty for teaching excellence on the IUPUI campus. Both full time and part time faculty are identified as recipients of the Schuyler F. Otteson Undergraduate Teaching Excellence Award.

Schuyler F. Otteson served as Dean of Kelley School of Business from 1971 to 1982. During that timeframe, the enrollments in the school of business had increased 90%. The award is given in his name due to his dedication and improvements to the Kelley School of Business.

This form is a **Nomination Form** for students to nominate professors that they feel have displayed teaching excellence in all areas. Students may only nominate professors that they have had in class for the current academic year. A committee comprised of KSBISG Executives and distinguished Kelley Staff will determine the winner of the Schuyler F. Otteson Award. The winners will be announced and awarded at commencement.

The following are some criteria to consider as you write your short nomination:

1. How did the nominated professor fulfill his/her duties as a professor?
2. Did the professor entice you to learn about the subject matter beyond what the course required?
3. How did you benefit overall from this course with this professor?
4. What sets this professor apart from your other Kelley professors?
5. Would you recommend this professor to other IUPUI and Kelley students? Why?

These are only suggestions and are to help you begin your essay. Please do not consider the above criteria as limits to your nomination.
